The Concept

Kiosks, located in print and framing shops, provide access to a large collection of high resolution images available via the Internet. Customers can browse through the collection, select images to print, and then specify the image size and even the type of paper to print on.

Images are printed on high quality, high-resolution ink jet printers and can be completed in as little as an hour.

Digital printing has, within the last few years, achieved quality and longevity that rivals and even surpasses traditional printing technologies. High quality ink-jet printers can now produce high-resolution images that will last for many years.



Prints on Demand Kiosk



The kiosk consists of an Internet-connected personal computer with a large monitor for viewing and selecting images and a large format printer for producing the finished prints. The printer can produce prints up to 24 or 44 inches wide and several feet long from roll stock.
